Rushmore Electric Federal Credit Union Scholarship Guidelines

1. A scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who is a member of Rushmore Electric Federal Credit Union.
2. Family members of employees and credit union officials will be eligible for this scholarship as an unbiased scholarship committee will make the selection.
3. The applicant must be attending an accredited two year, four year, or more college or vocational/technical school.
4. Applications must be submitted or postmarked to REFCU no later than **February 2, 2018**.
5. All applications must be received with the Rushmore Electric Federal Credit Union Scholarship application form, and the questionnaire to ensure the committee will have the same information from all applicants.
6. The winner of the scholarship will receive a \$1,000 check made payable to both the applicant and the school of their choice.
